A WALK DOWN THE PATH

On: Back to the Future

One of the truly imaginative and entertaining "science documentaries" of the last few decades is the *Back to the Future* movie trilogy. Who can forget Marty, Doc, Biff, and all the other key figures who bounced around the present, the past, and the future. Regardless of what decade of what century Marty and Doc were found in, they experienced similar calamities, dealt with interesting challenges, utilized similar ideas adapted to their times, and creatively produced positive results. Rolling Hills will also be going back to the future, in a sense, this fall.

Beginning in the late 1980's for about 20 years, Rolling Hills Christian Church employed college students (most of whom attended Manhattan Christian College) to work as ministry interns in various positions on weekends. Most of them worked with Student Ministries (children and youth) while a few worked in Music Ministry or specialized in either Children Ministry or Youth Ministry.

Our goal was two-fold: 1) utilize the abilities of interested students for part-time ministry work, and 2) provide a training platform for college students to learn and develop ministry skills for a potential future career choice. As a result, we assisted the Kingdom in multiple ways. Some students went on to develop solid ministries in many different states. Some students learned that ministry was not the best use of their interests. Most of the students had very positive and lasting effects on the children and teenagers of Rolling Hills.

For the past decade, we put that aspect of our ministry of the shelf for a variety of reasons. This past year the board decided to return to this ministry aspect of our congregation. So, we're pulling the Student Ministries Intern position off the shelf, dusting it off, and getting it ready to function. After interviewing several candidates,

beginning last fall, we are ready to go back to the future.

On Sunday, August 20, we will introduce a young man to our congregation who has accepted the invitation to be our next intern. Dylan Meyer will be a sophomore at Manhattan Christian College in the fall semester of 2017. He is pursuing a B.A. in Christian Ministry with emphasis in Youth and Pastoral Ministry. During these summer months, he has been traveling on a student team representing M.C.C. Dylan hails from Burlington, KS, where he became a Christian, and his family was active in the local Christian Church. In reply to a text I sent him recently about our plans and dates, Dylan commented: *Things are going well this summer. I've been busy but it's all been for the Kingdom. I am really excited to be working with you. I have those dates in my calendar and should be ready to go.*

On August 20, when we introduce Dylan to Rolling Hills, we will also have a carry-in dinner to provide an opportunity for everyone to visit with Dylan and get to know him a little bit.

Dylan will begin his intern ministry with Rolling Hills on Sunday, September 10, which will be our Fall Kickoff Sunday. Dylan's ministry initially will be on Sundays only, unless he schedules events on another day, as well. As time progresses, that may very well extend to include Saturdays, which was our practice in our previous intern experiences.

Please plan to be present to meet Dylan on August 20. We believe everyone will be suitably impressed with this fine young man. Bring great food (i.e. chocolate desserts) for the carry-in dinner. Sit around and visit with Dylan. Ask him questions and encourage him in the Lord. I'm looking forward to returning to the future here at Rolling Hills.
