Fully Devoted

Each Bible story based lesson is taught in a way to lead children to become fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ by speaking into their heart, soul, mind, and strength.

“And you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.’ The second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ No other commandment is greater than these.” Mark 12:30-31 NLT

Heart: We lead kids to desire God.

When we say, “Every day, I am who Jesus says I am,” we are leading kids to desire intimacy with God. We find our deepest and truest identity in our relationship with Christ, not in the things of this world.

Soul: We lead kids to trust God.

When we say, “Every day, I can trust Jesus,” we are leading kids to trust God not only as the Creator and Lord of all, but also personally when they choose to follow Jesus. God is always good, and He is with them in every circumstance.

But I trust in you, LORD; I say, “You are my God.” Psalm 31:14 NIV

Mind: We lead kids to know God.

When we say, “Every day, I reflect Jesus to others,” we are leading kids to know Jesus personally so that their lives can be transformed. When we know God, it shows in our relationships.

“You are the light of the world.” Matthew 5:14 NIV

Strength: We lead kids to serve God.

When we say, “Every day, I make choices that honor Jesus,” we are challenging kids to make choices that put Jesus first and show love to others. That posture leads to living a life of service that honors God.

“Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.” John 13:34b NLT
